1. Writing Support

At the end of the program, a finished manuscript must be submitted along with a project completion letter along with itemized statement. Eighty percent of the grant must be returned should the publication fail to be published within the project period. Upon publication, a statement that the book was published with support from the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism and Korea Arts Management Service must be written in the copyright section along with the logo.

- Program Details: Covers writing, translation, and editing fees for a book to be published overseas
 Manuscripts completed through the Writing Support program are eligible for the Publishing Support program for support with publishing expenses.

□ Grant Scope: Up to KRW 50 mil. (approx. USD 42,000)

 \circ Support Scope: writing, translation, editing, and publisher fees for producing a completed manuscript

- Appropriation of Grant Amount
 - · Writing: KRW 216,000 (approx. USD 180) per one A4-size page
 - · Translation: KRW 216,000 per one A4-size page
 - * Appropriation Basis: 480 English words per one A4-size page, up to 100 pages supported
 - * The sum of writing and translation fees cannot exceed KRW 21,600,000.
 - * Translation fee should exceed 70 percent of the sum of writing and translation fees.
 - · Editing: up to 50 percent of translation charge rate
 - \cdot Publisher fee: up to 10 percent of total grant amount
 - \cdot Desired grant amount cannot exceed 80 percent of the total writing budget
 - \cdot Any cost overrun is the responsibility of the applicant and publisher

X Once an applicant receives a writing grant, support for translation and editing fees cannot be requested again in the application for the Publishing Support program.

\Box Selection Method

 \circ Document review and interview will proceed only upon confirmation of a publishing contract with an overseas publisher.

 \circ Review Criteria: Relevance of content, rationality and credibility of publication plan, capabilities of the publisher, potential use and impact of the publication

□ **Grant Payment Method**: Payment will be made to the applicant's overseas publisher upon conclusion of an MOA between KAMS and the overseas publisher entered into based on the publishing contract.

- * The publishers' written agreement to the terms of grant payment and other details (standardized format provided) must be submitted.
- □ **Output Submission:** A finished manuscript and a project completion letter with itemized statement must be submitted within the project period.
 - X Manuscript must be completely written, translated, and edited before submission.
 - * If an output is not submitted within the project period, the contract will be canceled and 80 percent of the grant must be returned.
 - % If the output has fewer pages than stated in the plan, KAMS can request for additional pages to account for the provided writing fee.

At the end of the program, 30 copies of the published book must be delivered to KAMS along with statements of disbursement (payment, transfer records and other evidential documents). Upon publication, a statement that this book was published with support from the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism and Korea Arts Management Service must be written in the copyright section along with the logo.

 - (2nd year) January 2021 December 2021
 - (3rd year) January 2022 December 2022
 - % Final output must be submitted within the project period
 - * Detailed production and publication schedule and plan must be provided in the "Project Period and Schedule" field of the application form.
 - X An interim check will be held 6 months prior to the end of the project period. The project period can be extended if necessary.
- □ **Program Details:** Covers translation and publishing expenses for a book to be published overseas

□ Grant Scope

- Support Scope: Up to KRW 50 mil. (approx. USD 42,000)
- \circ Appropriation of Grant Amount
 - · Translation: KRW 216,000 (approx. USD 180) per one A4-size page (approx. 480 words)
 - \cdot Editing: up to 50 percent of translation charge rate
 - \cdot Expenses incurred for publication such as image copyright, design, copyediting, and printing can be covered with submission of detailed statements on desired amounts.
 - Desired grant amount cannot exceed 80 percent of the total publishing budget.
 - \cdot Any cost overrun is the responsibility of the applicant and publisher.

□ Selection Method

 \circ Document review and interview will proceed only upon confirmation of a publishing contract with an overseas publisher.

 \circ Review Criteria: Relevance of content, rationality and credibility of publication plan, capabilities of the publisher, potential use and impact of the publication

□ **Grant Payment Method**: Payment will be made to the applicant's overseas publisher upon conclusion of an MOA between KAMS and the overseas publisher entered into based on the publishing contract.

* The publishers' written agreement to the terms of grant payment and other details (standardized format provided) must be submitted.


□ **Output Submission:** 30 copies of the published book and a project completion letter along with itemized statement must be submitted within the project period.

% The total number of printed copies must exceed 1,000.

% If an output is not published within the project period, the contract will be canceled and 80 percent of the grant must be returned.

× Books published through the publishing support program are eligible for the Purchase and Distribution Support program.
